## PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO ARTICLES

### SEVENTH(b)

b. The officers of the corporation are the President, Immediate past president,, four Regional Vice Presidents, three Service Representatives (one from the Navy, one from the Marine Corps and one from the Coast Guard), Reserve Representative, Retired Representative, Secretary, Treasurer, Membership Director, Judge Advocate, Historian, Chaplain, Public Affairs Officer, [and] Master-at-Arms **and Parliamentarian**.

### SEVENTH (c)

c. The General Assembly shall, at the National Conference, elect the officers of the corporation with the exception of the Immediate Past President (who assumes the office by virtue of the position); the three Service Representatives (who shall be elected by the respective service); the Reserve Representative and the Retired Representative (who shall be elected by the reserve and retired communities); and the Judge Advocate (who shall be appointed by the President). The term of office for the three Service Representatives (one from the Navy, one from the Marine Corps and one from the Coast Guard) and the Reserve Representative and the Retired Representative shall be for one (1) year. The term of office for the President, Immediate Past President, four Regional Vice Presidents, Secretary, Treasurer, Membership Director, Judge Advocate, Historian, Chaplain, Public Affairs Officer, [and] Master-at-Arms **and Parliamentarian** shall be for two (2) years and the officers shall be elected in accordance with paragraph 7g herein. The Judge Advocate shall continue to be appointed by the President and there shall be nothing to prevent the appointment of a new Judge Advocate by the President during his/her two year term. Those elected to serve as Regional Vice Presidents must reside in the region or be assigned to duty stations within those regions, or have orders to transfer to such duty station at the time they are elected.

### SEVENTH (g)

g. In the year 200[6] **8** (and all even numbered years thereafter) the General Assembly shall, at the National Conference elect the President, Secretary, Membership Director, Chaplain, Western Regional Vice President, Central Regional Vice President [and] Master-at-Arms **and Parliamentarian** for two year terms; these officers shall be elected every two years thereafter. In the year 2006 the General Assembly shall, at the National Conference elect the, Eastern Regional Vice President, Far Eastern Regional Vice President, for a term of one year. In the year 2007 the General Assembly shall, at the National Conference elect the, Eastern Regional Vice President, Far Eastern Regional Vice President, Treasurer, Historian, and Public Affairs Officer for a term of two years; these officers shall be elected every two years thereafter (in odd numbered years). In

the year 2006 the General Assembly shall, at the National Conference elect the three Service Representatives (one from the Navy, one from the Marine Corps and one from the Coast Guard) and the Reserve Representative and the Retired Representative for a term of one year; these officers shall be elected every year thereafter. The three Service Representatives and the Reserve Representative and the Retired Representative shall be elected by their respective service/community and ratified by the General Assembly.

## PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO BYLAWS

### BYLAW IV DUTIES OF OFFICERS

Section 7. JUDGE ADVOCATE: The Judge Advocate shall review proposed amendments to the articles and bylaws. The Judge Advocate shall bring to the attention of the Board of Directors any legal problems that may confront the Association. [At all National conferences, the Judge Advocate shall assume the role of the Parliamentarian]. Within thirty days of the end of each National Conference, the Judge Advocate shall publish and distribute approved copies of any revised articles and bylaws to the Board of Directors and the Chapter Presidents. The Judge Advocate shall cause to be maintained the original Articles of Incorporation and the current copy of the Bylaws.

**Section 13 PARLIAMENTARIAN: The Parliamentarian at all meetings of the Board of Directors as well as at all National Conferences shall assume the role of the Parliamentarian.**
