<p>Professional Development FITNESS REPORTS/SELECTION BOARDS</p> <p>Speakers: CAPT Jeff Lee, CO, CGC Hamilton, VADM (RET) Moore and COL Warren Foersch MCRD San Diego</p>	<p>CAPT Lee: -provided a current OER powerpoint presentation for USCG FITREPs. In it, he emphasized 28 core competencies which will be reinforced by the USCG new commandant. -He points out the difference between USN and USCG ranking system in that, USCG ranks by a standard vice marks. -The board is gender neutral. The members do not know the name or gender of record being reviewed.</p> <p>VADM Moore: -Familiarize yourself with the pre-cept message which is sent out before the board convenes. -Review your records before board deadline and ensure that there are no gaps of your service. If there is a gap, then you must take steps to resolve it or have a document explanation of the gap. -Explained the procedure of the convening board. How records are screened and reviewed.</p> <p>COL Foersch: -sit down with your CO and tell him/her what you think your job entails and he/she will in turn either confirms or correct. -It is important to establish a pattern of performance. -go for the hard assignments and make yourself indispensable. -Keep a list of billet accomplishments -Don't do anything to attract special attention to your records (i.e. letter to the board) -Don't put number 49% on FITREP. Instead, put, top half or something of the sort. -Don't go outside of your billet. Don't do a joint tour unless it is forced upon you. More than 1 out of billet assignments decreases your competitiveness.</p>
