



Ms. Ruby Miller

Ruby Miller was selected as the Director, Administrative and Logistics Support Division for the Office of Operations Coordination, Department of Homeland Security (DHS) in July 2006. Prior to her arrival at DHS, she served as the Deputy Director, Center for Minority Veterans for the Department of Veterans Affairs' (VA) from July 2002 to July 2006.

During her tenure at the Department of Veterans Affairs, Ms. Miller also served as a Management Analyst in the VA's Office of Human Resources Management for Workforce Planning. In this position she was responsible for planning and coordinating a VA wide recruitment and marketing initiative.

Prior to her employment at Veterans Affairs, Ms. Miller held various management positions in the private sector. A Navy veteran, Ms. Miller retired in September 1999 as a Commander (O5). In her 23 years of naval service she held numerous leadership, operational and management positions on senior Navy staffs, and was selected twice to Command. She has received numerous military decorations, and civilian awards and citations, to include the Department of Veterans Affairs Meritorious Service Award.

A 2004 Leadership VA (LVA) graduate, Ms. Miller graduated from the University of Colorado with a B.S. in Journalism and attained a M.S. in *National Security and Strategic Studies* from the Naval War College and M.S. *International Relations at Salve Regina University*. She was among the select few nominated as a *Navy Federal Executive Fellow* to study Post-Soviet military strategy and Central Asian politics at Boston University and Harvard University.
