



## CDR TONY GORDON

A native of the Bronx, New York, Commander Tony Gordon is a 1990 graduate of the University of Maryland, College Park with a B.A. in Political Science. He received his commission as an ensign from the George Washington University NROTC Unit that same year.

He served for eight years and a half years on active duty as a Surface Warfare Officer and his tours included the USS ENTERPRISE (CVN 65), USS SOUTH CAROLINA (CGN 37) and shore duty at Afloat Training Group Mayport. He left active duty in 1999 and continued to serve his military career as a drilling reservist in units in New Orleans, LA and Charlotte, NC. His civilian employment included stints as a sales account executive with Blanchard & Co. and as a recruiter for DeVry University in New Orleans, LA and Charlotte, NC respectively.

CDR Gordon re-entered the active duty force on Active Duty for Special Work (ADSW) in 2005 and was assigned as the Officer In Charge (OIC), of the US Fleet Forces Shipping Coordination Center Pacific located on Coast Guard Island, Alameda CA where he served until September 2007. He is currently assigned as the OIC of the Shipping Coordination Center Atlantic located at Naval Station Oceana Annex Dam Neck.
